

School Guidance Document for Tobacco-Free Policy Communication

Sample memo to school board from superintendent

Dear School Board,

ACT 351 of the 2017 Legislative Session requires a review and potential update to our district's tobacco-free policy for students, faculty and visitors. The updates to look out for are below.

- Prohibits tobacco use on school property used for educational purposes (facilities owned, leased, or rented by the organization, including parking lots)
- Does not include designated smoking areas
- Defines tobacco to include all types of smoking and smokeless tobacco products
- Includes smoking devices (e-cigarettes)
- Prohibits tobacco use in school buses and school vehicles (if applicable)
