





Deliver and support quality clinical services that bridge treatment, prevention and health promotion.



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

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•	Patient Eligibility
	 Uninsured or underinsured AND below 300% FPL Underinsured = public or private ins. but cannot afford copays, no drug coverage
•	Dispensing
	 Provided for free to eligible patients
•	Storage
	 Segregated from other donated or purchased medications Stickers, signage
•	Tracking
	 By lot number to the patient level
•	Destruction
	 Expired products to be destroyed
	 Cannot be returned to manufacturer for credit

Psychological First Aid (PFA)

This abbreviated PFA training provides information on how and when to provide psychological first aid to people impacted by a traumatic event, and ways to enhance provider care before, during and after a traumatic event.

Resiliency and Coping for the Healthcare Community

To support those who have been effected by a disaster or traumatic event and how to cope with related stressors.

Self-Care Strategies for the Busy Health Professional

The goal of this training is to increase the ability of providers to identify natural emotional responses to crises and learn to manage stress reactions and improve self-care for themselves and among the people they serve.
